"The Predators and the New NHL"

The 2005-06 NHL season has been one of great changes both on and off the ice for the Nashville Predators and the National Hockey League.

A new Collective Bargaining Agreement has brought about dramatic changes to team payroll disparity and the way organizations build their teams. On the ice, significant rule changes were implemented to emphasize the speed and skill of the game and make the game even more appealing to fans.

Predators Executive Vice President David Poile, also a member of the NHL Rules Committee, will address the impact these changes have had on the Predators and share his observations on the current season as well as his vision for the team's future.
